You will have the opportunity to learn how to make some charcoal on an open beach fire, which you will then take to use in the creative session with Gina, Creative Connector, and learn how to make mixed media pictures. You may also have time to create a collage using items found, for instance shells. Using a selection of oils, pastels, crayons and coloured pencils you will be able to create sketches of the land and seascapes and items discovered at Compton Bay.

Exploring Compton Bay during a spring low tide will be very interactive, creative and hands-on, enabling you to experience a really fun and exciting learning opportunity. You will be able to switch off, get up close and connect with nature and each other.
